- Cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better
- Verifiable recent or current Community Service
- Must be able to attend the TAP Foundation Benefit Concert

### Application Process

- Must complete the attached application in its entirety
- Provide two current letters of recommendation (Must be from a teacher, school professional, community leader, employer or professional reference)
- Provide most recent high school or college transcript
- Acceptance letter from an accredited two- or four- year college/university
- Provide high school or college resume
- Provide any awards, commendations, citations and achievements
- Provide 1<sup>st</sup> page of tax forms from parent, guardian or custodian with social security numbers redacted (removed)
- **Incomplete, illegible or applications postmarked after the deadline will not be considered**

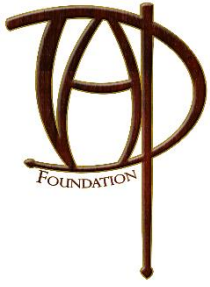
### Awards

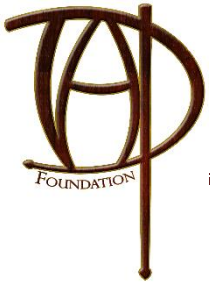
